Dear Hon. Rabner:

I'm writing this letter requesting that your office intercede in the current case against Chief Kenneth Henderson of the Bound Brook Police Department in Somerset County.

Since his arrest, over two years ago, several issues have been uncovered which cast doubt on the circumstances surrounding this case. This includes the methods used in the investigation; how the information was presented to the Grand Jury, and how information that is not factual was utilized in the basis for criminal affidavits.

Further included are discrepancies in the evidence presented, how this evidence was distorted, and in some cases perhaps fabricated. In the public motions filed by the defense team for Chief Henderson there are a compelling number of questions that have to be addressed as to how the Somerset County Prosecutor conducted this investigation. These questions focus on the distortion of the Prosecutor's own facts, fabrication of evidence, deliberate omission of exculpatory evidence and perhaps even presentation of false testimony by members of the Somerset County Prosecutor's Office.

As the person who investigated the former Somerset County Prosecutor, Nicholas Bissell, you are well aware of the devastating impact to the citizens an abusive Prosecutor can wield. In this case, a professional law enforcement officer, a sitting Chief of Police, has become the victim of similar abuse. This case screams out for you, as the Chief Law Enforcement Officer for the State of New Jersey, to at least look over the investigation tactics and resulting misrepresentation of facts (which may border on criminal perjury) of the Somerset County Prosecutor and members of his office.

The citizens of New Jersey, and especially Somerset County, have to be assured that their government is acting according to the law and in their best interest. We do not need another example of Prosecutor abuse that is discovered after people have been harmed.

I implore you to honor this request and open an investigation into this case.
